

## Week 5—Your Friends Without Christ

This week pray for your friends that have not yet believed.

- Ask for God to give you a burdened spirit for your friends who are not followers of Christ and that you would have opportunities to share the gospel with them.
- Pray for your friends without Christ, by name, that God would show them their desperate need for Jesus.
- If you currently do not have any friends without Christ, ask God to bring people into your life that you would be able to demonstrate the love of Christ to them.
- Ask for God to protect and guard your heart as you seek to love others whose sin might tempt you to give in to sinful behavior. Pray for purity in your words, thoughts, and actions as you love your friends without Christ.
- *Scripture: John 3:16; Acts 4:12; Rom. 3:23; 6:23; 10:9-10*

## February 2019 PRAYER GUIDE

### Psalm 17:6 (ESV)

*I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God; incline your ear to me; hear my words.*

This year at Oakhill Baptist Church we are emphasizing the importance of prayer by providing a monthly prayer guide that will help structure and organize the prayers of our people. Each month a new guide will be distributed and a new theme will be introduced. Our hope is that by using this prayer guide we will see an increase in reliance on prayer in our church and that God would gain much glory and honor in the spiritual growth of his people.

### February Theme: Relationships

In February, we ask that you would pray specifically for the different relationships that you have in your life. In praying for one another, we hope that God will grow our love for others as we seek to love our neighbors as ourselves.

## Week 1— Your Family

This week pray specifically for your immediate family.

- Thank God for the blessing of family and being able to be a part of His family through salvation in Christ.
- Pray that God would give you grace to love your family selflessly in word and deed as He has loved you.
- If you are married, pray that you would love your spouse faithfully and die to yourself daily. (Luke 9:23)
- If you are single, pray that you would find fulfillment in God's sufficiency to meet your needs in your time of life.
- Ask God to guard and protect your family from the influence of the world, the flesh, and the devil.
- Pray for the salvation of any family members who have not yet trusted in Christ for salvation.
- *Scripture: Eph. 5:22-33; 1 Cor. 13:1-13; Col. 3:13-15*

## Week 2—Your Parents and Kids

This week pray for your kids and your parents.

- Pray for your children's and/or parents' physical health.
- If you are a parent, pray that God will help you to be faithful in training and discipling your children in the Lord.
- If you are a child growing up in your parents' home, pray that God will help you to obey your parents in the Lord.
- Pray for a heart that honors your father and mother.
- Pray for healing and restoration from past hurts.
- Pray for repentance and forgiveness to be modeled and reciprocated within parent/child relationships
- Pray fervently that God will change the hearts of your parents and children who do not know Him and that they will be saved.
- *Scripture: Eph. 6:1-4; Duet. 6:4-9; Ps. 127:3-5; Prov. 6:20, 22:6; Ex. 20:12; Col 3:18-25; Matt. 19:19; Mark 10:6-9*

## Week 3—Your Church Family

This week pray for your church family.

- Pray that you and your brothers and sisters in Christ will be faithful to disciple one another and make new disciples.
- Ask God to be glorified as we seek to worship the Him together in one spirit and mind, unified in Christ.
- Pray that your church family would be faithful to read God's Word, meditate on it, and apply it each week.
- Pray that God would move us to encourage and exhort one another by speaking the truth in love. (Eph. 4:15)
- Pray that each person in our church would use their gifts and talents in service to God for His glory.
- Thank God for giving you the spiritual family that he has blessed you with at our church.
- *Scripture: Ps. 133:1, 1 Cor. 1:10, 12:12-26; 1 John 4:20*

## Week 4—Your Neighbors

This week pray for all of those people that live near you.

- Ask for God to give you a heart to be more intentional to build relationships with your neighbors in order to share the love of Christ with them.
- Pray for your neighbors who do not trust in Christ that God would begin working on their hearts and opening their eyes to the truth of the Gospel.
- Pray about hosting your neighbors at your house, inviting them to church, or simply building friendships with them to show them what Christian community looks like.
- If there is conflict between you and your neighbor, ask God to help you reconcile and restore your relationship.
- Pray that God would use you to be a blessing in the lives of your neighbors. Ask God for ways to serve your neighbors.
- *Scripture: Luke 10:25-37; Rom. 12:14-21; 1 Cor. 10:24*
