

Week 5— The Follow Up

This week pray that God would give more opportunities in the future to follow up with “your one” about the gospel.

- Thank God for the time you have been able to spend sharing with “your one” about the gospel and that you would follow up with future opportunities to share.
- Pray for patience, perseverance, and peace of mind as you continue to minister to “your one”.
- Ask for God to begin burdening your heart for another “one” that you can begin to build a relationship with in order to share the gospel.
- Pray that God would use our church collectively to reach many people who do not know Christ in faith.
- Pray for God’s heart of forgiveness to take root in your own so that you never lose perspective of the Great Commission that we have been given. (Matt.28:18-20)

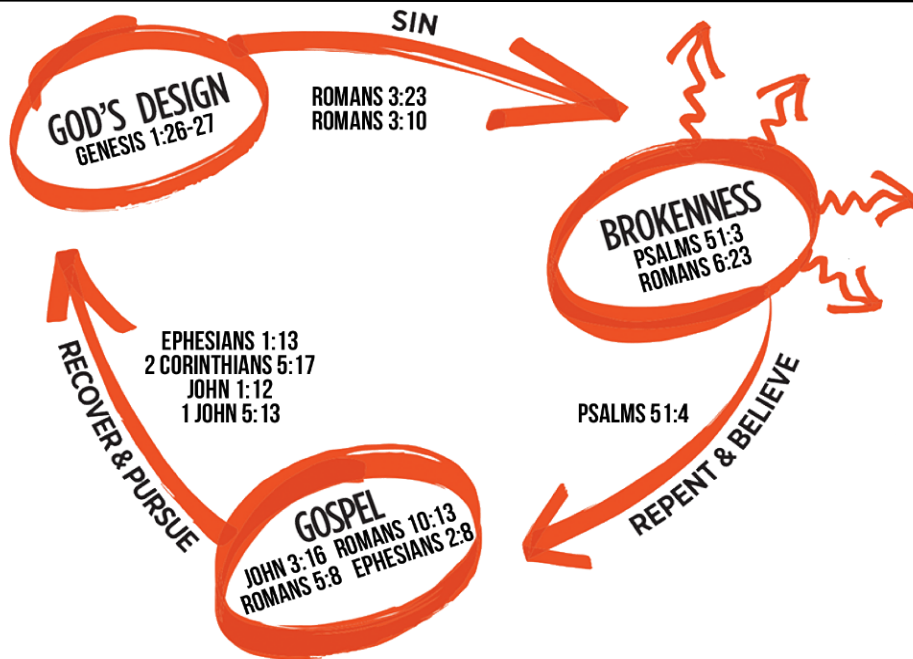
April 2019 PRAYER GUIDE



This year at Oakhill Baptist Church we are emphasizing the importance of prayer by providing a monthly prayer guide that will help structure and organize the prayers of our people. Each month a new guide will be distributed and a new theme will be introduced. Our hope is that by using this prayer guide we will see an increase in reliance on prayer in our church and that God would gain much glory and honor in the spiritual growth of his people.

April Theme: Who’s Your One?

This month we want to challenge our church to ask the question, “Who’s your one?” We want each person in our church to begin asking God to burden their heart with at least one person that does not know Jesus as Savior and Lord. This month’s guide will help you know how to pray for “your one”, for God to work on their heart, and for you to share with them.

Week 1— The Gospel

This week thank God for the gospel and ask that he would use it to change someone else's life through you.

- Thank God for not leaving you dead in your sin, but making you alive together with Christ, raising you up with him, and seating you with him in the heavenly places (Eph. 2:1-7).
- Meditate on the various habits of sin that Christ has set you free from and how you can now live for his glory.
- Thank God for the person that shared the good news of the gospel with you that led to your salvation.
- Ask that God would use you to share with someone else about how the gospel has changed your life and how it can change their life as well.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would strengthen you to live in a way that loves God and others and hates sin.

Week 2— Who's Your One?

This week ask for God to burden your heart for at least one person to share the gospel with.

- Pray for God to show you at least one person that you know needs to hear about the gospel and believe in Jesus for forgiveness of their sins.
- Pray for this person that God would be working on his/her heart and making them more receptive of God's truth.
- Pray that God would strengthen in your mind a way to winsomely present the gospel to this person. Our church recommends the 3 Circles conversation guide (posted on the back of this pamphlet) as a great way to start a conversation with someone about the gospel.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit would kill your apathy or pride and calm your fears and anxieties about talking to this person about Jesus. Trust in God's love for you.

Week 3— The Invitation

This week pray that God would move you to invite "your one" to be a part of our church's Easter events.

- Ask "your one" to join you at our church on Easter Sunday.
- Pray for God to use the Good Friday Night of Worship and the Community Easter Egg Hunt as ways to help build interest in knowing more about the gospel.
- If they do not accept your invitation, pray that God would open up another opportunity for them to come with you.
- Pray that the gospel would be clearly preached and offered on Sunday and that people would respond to the free offer of God's grace.
- Pray that God would give you opportunities to invite "your one" into the life of your family. Ask for God to help you practice hospitality as a way to show caring love.

Week 4— The Presentation

This week pray that God would use you to share about Jesus Christ's life, death, and resurrection with "your one".

- Pray for God to give you a clear, undisturbed opportunity to share with "your one" about how the gospel has changed your life and how it can change their life too.
- Pray that God would use your efforts to penetrate their lostness and regenerate their heart in faith in Christ.
- If they choose to reject your presentation, continue to pray for them that God would still be working to draw them to himself. Ask for God to grow your friendship with this person so they can see the love of Christ as time passes.
- Ask God to help you trust in His work of opening eyes, renewing hearts, and raising the spiritually dead. Trust in his power, ability, and love for "your one" (Eph. 3:20).
- Thank God for giving the privilege of sharing the gospel.
